Dear Mr. Burnham:

By letter dated August 30, 2005, you informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff of a change in the Project Manager and address for the ExxonMobil Refining and Supply Company Highland Reclamation Project. Correspondingly, you requested that License Condition (LC) 2 of Source Materials License SUA-1139 be revised to reflect the new address for the ExxonMobil Highland Reclamation Project. As requested, the staff has revised LC 2 of the license for the Highland facility to incorporate the organizational change provided in your letter. This revision is provided as License Amendment 57 to Source Materials License SUA-1139. The amended Highland license is enclosed. This change to the Highland license is purely administrative and, as such, is categorically excluded from environmental review under 10 CFR Part 51.22(c)(11).
