Enclosed is Amendment No. 17 renewing your NRC Material License No. 21-17754-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold font**. In addition, format changes were made to your license to conform with currently NRC policy. These changes are not in bold font.

Also note that Dr. David Fleszar could not be added to your license as an authorized user at this time. The board certification submitted with your request is dated 1992, a period greater than seven years. If you wish to pursue this matter, please review 10 CFR 35.59 and the enclosed NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2003-17 for guidance on the information needed to add Dr. Fleszar as an authorized user.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
