In regards to the changes in Part 26, I fully support the changes being made. As an NLO, we currently work the standard 8-hour 6-crew shift schedule. However, due to losses and illness we at present only have 44 NLO's with 48 required for the schedule. This results in overtime on virtually all shifts. I believe that these new rules will force the owners/ operators of power plants to increase staffing levels and reduce overtime. Moreover, I am convinced that the 10 hours off between shifts will significantly improve operator alertness levels.
