Dear Mr. Holonich:

On July 22, 2005, I notified the NRC that WRT Uranium, LLC intended to submit a license application for its Uranium Removal System for treating water from Community Water Systems to meet the requirements of USEPA's Radionuclide Rule. There are several companies within the Water Remediation Technology operating group of companies, two of which were originally intended to be the companies responsible to handle the radioactive residuals from the treatment systems. WRT Uranium, LLC was one of these companies, and the original intent was to have it handle the uranium residuals and be the licensee for the uranium systems. The other company, R.M.D. Operations, LLC, is the company that already holds licenses for the operation of WRT's Radium Removal System. A decision has been made to simplify the overall group structure to have only one company, R.M.D. Operations, LLC, responsible for handling and disposing of all radioactive materials resulting from any of the water treatment systems. This decision was made, primarily, to simplify the licensing processes that may be required for the different radionuclides and between Agreement and Non-Agreement states.

Accordingly, the upcoming License Application and Environmental Report that we plan to submit next month will be in the name of R.M.D. Operations, LLC, rather than WRT Uranium, LLC. Please call me if you have any comments or questions related to this issue.
