SUPERIOR'S BILL FOR THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY SEVEN THOUSAND POUNDS AT SIXTY CENTS PLUS EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS SUPPLIES AND PICKLING COSTS IS EIGHTY NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS.
