This is to advise that 50 uranium slabs of the approximate dimensions, 1.25" x 8" x 80" are being shipped to your location from Superior Steel Corporation for surface conditioning.

We would appreciate it if American Machine & Foundry Company would machine these slabs by the removal of as much stock as may be required to clean up the surface (top and bottom only) providing that the finished slab thickness is not less than 1 inch.
