Bob,

It is my understanding that Rich and you talked concerning my request for information on the design and licensing basis of the Salem control pressurization issue. We identified two inspection reports that found the surveillance of the control room ventilation system was acceptable. In one report (98-12) it mentions outstanding licensing activities (ie FSAR or design basis changes in the reference for measuring the control room pressure). In the second it mentions test deficiencies and finds the licensee test implementation to be acceptable.

Do you have any outstanding actions the change the design basis or license in this area. In addition, do we have any licensing basis issues with the licensee's response to GL99-02. I understand that you are discussing this problem with the previous PM and I appreciate your assistance. The energy level associated with this issue is does not based on its risk significance. We are under a moderate amount of time related pressure to answer an allegation in the next couple of days before tripping over a milestone. If it is possible, I would like to talk about this issue some time tomorrow. What time would be convenient for you?
