Subject: Salem Firewatch

At Barry Letts' request, I reviewed RI-98-A-0062 to determine whether enforcement action against the individual would be warranted if wrongdoing was substantiated.

The individual was a low-level individual, the violation was of low safety significance (SL IV), and the licensee took significant action against the individual (termination); therefore, I concluded that enforcement action against the individual would not be warranted. Jim Lieberman concurred with this conclusion.

Jim L. indicated that we should obtain an EA number and disposition the violation as a "willful" NCV in accordance with section VII.B.1 of the Enforcement Policy so that the violation could be tracked in case of future problems of this type at Salem (i.e., it turns out not to be an isolated case).

Subsequently, I spoke with Barry Letts. He indicated that although this is a low priority case, OI intends to interview the individual. Therefore, no action should be taken to disposition the violation until after OI has concluded their efforts.
