SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMISSION ACTION: PROPOSED
RULEMAKING TO AMEND THE DESIGN BASIS THREAT
REQUIREMENTS IN 10 CFR PART 73.1 (3150-AH60)

By Staff Requirements Memorandum dated October 27, 2005 (ADAMS Accession Number ML053000448) on SECY-05-0106, the Secretary of the Commission indicated that the Commission approved publication for comment of a proposed rule revising the design basis threat requirements in 10 CFR Part 73.1 subject to the changes noted.
