Subject: Completion of NRC Staff Dose Assessment of Heritage Site

Summary: Discussed with licensee the following items:

- 1) NRC has completed the staff dose assessment of HMI. The dose assessment resulted in a dose > 25 mrem/year.
- 2) NRC will provide the dose assessment to HMI and to NJDEP, and will make the DA publically available. This will occur by 9/30/05. When this happens, all parties will be provided 30 days to comment on the DA. A conference call may be held between all parties to discuss the DA, after which a public meeting will be scheduled for further discussion.
- 3) When all comments are received on the DA and discussed, the NRC will consider comments and determine any impacts on the Commission paper for requesting license termination. Impacts may include adding an addendum to the DA. Regardless of such impacts, the comments received will be summarized and included in the Commission Paper.
- 4) The DA input provided by HMI in the letter dated 9/6 will not be considered until the DA has been provided to HMI and NJDEP. Once the actual document is reviewed by all parties, all comments will be considered at one time.

Action Required:

- 1) Send letter to HMI summarizing the call and receipt of 9/6 letter.
- 2) Provide DA to NJDEP and HMI and make publically available
- 3) Solicit comments on DA and schedule teleconference / meeting
