This letter serves as a request on behalf of Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL"), that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") provide me with photocopies of any and all documents and information pertaining to the matters described herein. This request is made pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552 *et seq.*

FPL requests any and all documents in the possession, custody or control of the NRC relating to the special safety inspection conducted by Mr. J. R. Wray of the NRC's Atlanta, Georgia, office on December 13-17, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License No. DPR-67 and Construction Permit No. CPPR-144 for FPL's St. Lucie facility. This special safety inspection resulted in Report Nos. 50-335/82-46 and 50-389/82-75; however, FPL has reason to believe that additional internal NRC documents may exist.

If you determine that some or all of the information requested above is exempt from release under FOIA, please advise me in writing which materials you deem exempt and the provision that you believe exempts such materials from being released. FPL requests copies of all non-exempt portions of any partially exempt materials, and expressly reserves its right to appeal any determination that an exemption

applies. In the event that a diligent search of your records fails to locate any responsive documents, FPL requests that a certified statement to that effect be provided.

FPL prefers to receive the requested records on a disk or CD-ROM if your agency has maintained the records in electronic format, hardcopy in the alternative. FPL agrees to pay all reasonable search and photocopying costs incurred in connection with the processing of this request. If, however, it becomes apparent that such costs may exceed \$500 or if you have any questions regarding this request, please call me at the address and telephone number on this letterhead. Please forward your invoice to me along with the documentation that I have requested on my client's behalf.
