# MONTICELLO NUCLEAR GENERATING PLANT LICENSE RENEWAL APPLICATION

#### **SEPTEMBER 1, 2005**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff (the staff) and representatives of Nuclear Management Company, LLC (NMC) held a telephone conference call on September 1, 2005, to discuss and clarify the applicant's responses to requests for additional information which were provided in letters dated July 21, 2005 and August 16, 2005, concerning the Monticello Nuclear Generating Plant license renewal application (LRA). The following issues were discussed during the telephone conference call.

1. The applicant was asked to explain how they determined the cumulative usage factor (CUF) increased to approximately 0.40 as a result of 10 improper recirculation loop startup cycles, as discussed in response to RAI 4.3.2-1

**<u>Discussion</u>**: The applicant provided the information to the staff.

2. The applicant was asked to provide a technical basis for using underground piping as an equivalent anchor, as discussed in their response to RAI 2.1-2.

<u>Discussion</u>: The applicant indicated that the question was clear, but needed time to provide the answer. A conference call was scheduled for the applicant to provide their response.
