1. We will begin preparation to conduct a scoping and characterization survey at Fort McClellan in FY94 per your request in the basic memorandum. We will need assistance from AEC, however, in two areas before we can begin the actual survey.

a. First, the funding to support this effort has not been identified. Your office will need to identify appropriate funds for this effort before we can proceed with this project. A cost estimate for the projected work for FY94 is provided in the enclosure. The cost estimate is for services associated with the radiological scoping and characterization surveys we scheduled for FY94.

b. Secondly, we request your support in coordinating with Fort McClellan the remediation of any toxic chemicals and/or explosive hazards that might be associated with Iron Mountain and Rideout Field. It is our understanding that your office, in conjunction with Fort McClellan personnel have been working this issue. Please keep us informed on the status of this evaluation. Before the requested radiological survey work can be performed on these sites, these sites must be rendered safe for our personnel. This office is available to assist you and Fort McClellan in developing and preparing radiological safety procedures for personnel performing this onsite evaluation. As these concerns are being addressed, we would appreciate the opportunity to start the requested work in the other areas.

2. We will await your reply on the availability of funds to support this project in FY94. Point of contact for this effort is Mr. Allen Hilsmeier, DSN 584-3502.
