INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS

ACCEPTANCE: This is to advise you that those individuals in Enclosure 1 have been accepted for participation in the training course (G-304) "Inspecting for Performance - Materials Version." This course is scheduled to be presented November 15-17, 2005, at the Red Lion Hotel Portland - Convention Center, 1021 NE Grand Avenue, Portland, OR 97232, Telephone (503) 235-2100.

COURSE: This course will be conducted beginning at 8:00 a.m. and end at 4:00 p.m. each day except for Thursday, November 17, 2005, when the class is scheduled to end at 12:00 noon. Please bring a calculator to this class.

LODGING AND TRAVEL: You should plan to arrive on Monday, November 14, 2005, and depart on Thursday, November 17, 2005. Participants must make their own lodging and travel arrangements. Individuals should request a State or government employee rate at Red Lion Hotel. Please make reservations as soon as possible and ask to be booked in the block of rooms reserved for the NRC course. Room rate will be \$93/night and the registrant must ask for the NRC course block of rooms to receive this rate since the Federal rate is going up October 1. Also, if students ask for the NRC course block of rooms, they will not have to pay for parking at \$8/night if they have a rental car. The Red Lion Hotel Portland is right on the MAX line (Public transportation light rail) and the one-way fare from the airport is \$1.80. It takes approximately 30 minutes to ride from the airport to the motel. While in the area the MAX is free from Lloyd Center to Pioneer Square in Downtown Portland.
