"However, we are deeply concerned that this inspection does not meet the scope and depth of the kind of diagnostic evaluations performed at other plants in crisis, such as Millstone, D.C. Cook, and

Maine Yankee."

New England Coalition will also insist that the inspection process be open to state and citizen review. "Twenty-five years of ongoing NRC inspections failed to keep track of missing fuel," said NEC Staff
