Summary: According to Mr. Pierno, they are keeping the old HDR (currently on license) until January when all training on the new unit is completed. The old unit has been repaired and will still be in use. Mr. Pierno was read the following from the initial paragraph of the cover letter to Amendment 85 of his license: "Based on discussions with James Pierno of your staff, we understand that you now plan to replace your existing Nucletron MicroSelectron Classic high dose rate remote afterloader (HDR) unit with the new Nucletron Model 105.999 HDR unit. Although you initially proposed to use the new HDR unit in Room XB-1, you now plan to install it in your simulator room, in the same location as your existing HDR unit." Mr. Pierno agreed with the foregoing statement.
