Mr. Arbogast:

IRM Group, Inc., is granted reciprocal recognition of the above stated license for conducting installation, repair and maintenance activities using radiation sources in the state of Texas, pursuant to Title 25 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §289.252(ee). This reciprocal recognition will expire on the date listed above.

In addition to the requirements and restrictions of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission license referenced above, the following conditions are imposed on your activities as a general licensee while conducting work in the state of Texas:

1. The licensee shall comply with the provisions (as amended) of Title 25 TAC §289.201, §289.202, §289.203, §289.204, §289.205, §289.251, §289.252 and §289.257.
2. The licensee shall have in their possession at all times when conducting work in Texas, and make available for review by the Agency staff upon request, the following:
 - a) a copy of this letter granting the licensee reciprocal recognition of their out-of-state license;
 - b) a copy of the licensee's operating and emergency procedures and all correspondence and items referenced in the license;
 - c) a copy of the licensee's radioactive material license;
 - d) a copy of 25 TAC §289.201, §289.202, §289.203, §289.204, §289.205, §289.251, §289.252 and §289.257 and
 - e) a copy of the appropriate BRC Form 252-3 notifying the Agency of the licensee's intent to work in Texas.

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3. If at any time during the reciprocity period of the license referenced above is amended, the licensee shall provide the Agency with copies of amendments to the license and any procedural changes pertaining to an amendment.

Submitting an application and/or licensee fees is only part of the process and does not grant reciprocity. This letter is your authorization to work in Texas.

You are required to notify this Department by the filing of a BRC Form 252-3 at least 3 days prior to each entry into Texas. This can be faxed to: Manager, Radiation Inspection Group at (512) 834-6654.

If at any time you establish a permanent office or site in Texas, you are required to apply for a Texas Radioactive Material License. 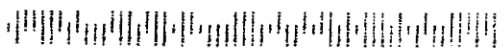

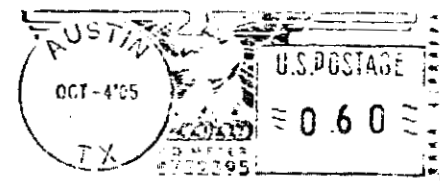
