AGENCY (IEPA) REGARDING THE REVIEW OF THE EXELON EARLY SITE  
PERMIT (ESP)

On September 13, 2005, Mr. Robert Mosher of the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) was contacted by Mr. Thomas Kenyon to discuss whether the agency had provided or intended to provide comments on the draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) concerning the early site permit (ESP) application at the Clinton ESP site, which was sent to IEPA on March 2, 2005.

Mr. Mosher stated that his supervisor (Toby Ferber, Division Manager) had told him that the group that looked at DEISs no longer exists due to downsizing. Mr. Mosher stated that he has been directed not to review the DEIS and, therefore will not be providing comments on it.

IEPA will follow the permitting process when Exelon decides to apply for the NPDES and 401 certification, but does not intend to consider it now. Therefore, Mr. Mosher informed me not to expect comments from the IEPA on the DEIS on the Clinton ESP project.
