Dear Mr. O'Dowd:

We received your letter dated September 22, 2005 requesting our review of a legally-binding license condition which has been added to all applicable New Hampshire Radioactive material Licenses. The license condition has been used to meet the compatibility requirements for the NRC regulations, "Resolution of Dual Regulation of Airborne Effluents of Radioactive Materials; Clean Air Act-Part 20," (61 FR 65120, (January 9, 2000)), RATS ID 1997-1.

A review of our records indicates that the license condition has been reviewed and found to meet the compatibility requirements as documented in a March 21, 2005 letter. We have also reviewed your proposed regulation addressing the 1997-1 amendment and found the proposed regulation compatible as documented in a May 13, 2005 letter. As indicated in the Mary 13 letter, we request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in STP Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight any final changes and provide a copy to STP. When the final rule becomes effective, the license condition would no longer be necessary.

Dear Mr. O'Dowd:

We have reviewed the New Hampshire license conditions that were submitted to address the NRC regulation associated with "Recognition of Agreement State Licenses in Areas Under Exclusive Federal Jurisdiction Within an Agreement State," (62 FR 1662, (January 13, 1997)), RATS ID 1997-2, received by our office on September 28, 2005. These license conditions were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent NRC rules in 10 CFR 150.20 and the requirements of the one amendment identified in the enclosed State's Regulation Status (SRS) Data Sheet. We discussed our review of the license condition with you on October 11, 2005.

As a result of our review, we have no comment. We have determined that the New Hampshire license conditions meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of State and Tribal Programs (STP) Procedure SA-200.

It should be noted that the proposed regulations which were implemented by this license condition were found acceptable in the May 13, 2005 STP letter. As discussed with you, we request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review. As requested in STP Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight any final changes and provide a copy to STP. When the final rule becomes effective, the license condition would no longer be necessary.
