
Per our conversation this date I am writing to notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding the status of the nuclear medicine service associated with the above mentioned NRC License issued to Valley Open MRI & Diagnostic Center, (Juan D. Gaia, M.D.) on or about September 30, 2003.

Valley Open MRI & Diagnostic Center (VOMRI) applied for the NRC License in anticipation of initiating a nuclear cardiac scanning service. Due to changing capital investment priorities the implementation of this service has been delayed. It remains VOMRI's plan to implement the service within the next 12 to 18 months. We therefore request that the above NRC License remain active and in effect.

VOMRI was notified that since the NRC License has not been activated VOMRI needed to inform the NRC of the status of the service to which the license pertains in order to avoid having the license lapse. In pursuit of complying with this requirement we respectfully request that this letter be considered as having established that notification and that the license remain in full effect.
