Enclosed is Amendment No. 37 to your NRC Material License No. 21-08317-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully, as many modifications, updates and reformatting changes have been made to your license, which are shown in **bold** font. Please be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

I noted that the materials listed as Subitem Nos. 6., 7., 8., and 9. E. and F. on Amendment No. 36 are now authorized by 10 CFR 35.65. Therefore I deleted these line items to conform with current licensing policy. Subsequent line items, conditions and authorized user listings have been re-ordered and/or modified as a result of these changes. This also necessitated deleting authority for Stanley Broussard and Dennis Szmania to use the strontium-90 sealed source for calibrations because such authority is now captured by 10 CFR 35.65.

The enclosed license document is exempt from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, because its disclosure to unauthorized individuals could present a security vulnerability.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This

could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
