I informed her that I had no further questions concerning the qualifications of Peixue Ma, Ph.D. I had spoken with the Radiation Safety Officer at Analytics, Inc. Who stated that all of the licensed material that they distributed to the Commonwealth of Virginia was possessed under Item 6.C. of the license. None of the licensed material was considered a sealed source and therefore a Sealed Source Registration Sheet was not required. Also, I had spoken with the Radiation Safety Officer of Isotope Products. He indicated that the source numbers that you provided were serial numbers for the sealed sources. He would have to check his records and determine the model numbers for the Americium-241 sources. I requested that Ms. Sanders reexamine the licensee's records to determine if she could identify the sealed source model numbers and if not, we would have to wait for the manufacturer's search to be completed.
