FRC is planning on moving the current nuclear medicine clinic to a new location and this request is for the approval of the new nuclear medicine space. Once the move is complete, the previous nuclear medicine clinic will be decommissioned and returned to general use. Once the new space is approved and new camera(s) are installed, it will become operational and the old clinic will start to shut down. For a short period of time both clinics may be in operation. The old space will become inactive when the camera(s) have been moved. The old clinic space will undergo decommissioning once all activity has ceased. Specific information is provided below.

See attached diagram of the space. The nuclear medicine clinic is part of the FRC Radiological Suite being installed at this location. The suite occupies the entire floor with nuclear medicine being located in the northeast corner. FRC controls all spaces adjacent to the clinic except for the adjacent hallway which is used for deliveries. The clinic consists of three imaging rooms, a thyroid uptake room, a patient bathroom, changing rooms, a central technician work

area, radiopharmacy and a separate injection room. The radiopharmacy has a sink, a small lead shielded area for the storage of the dose calibrator check sources and has a lead shielded "L" block with a leaded window for manipulation of radioactive doses. The sink is for hand washing, as no radioactive material will be disposed of through the sewer system. The clinic uses only unit doses supplied by a licensed commercial radiopharmacy. The doses are delivered to and stored in the radiopharmacy. All doses will be stored in their leaded shipping shields until used and the empty syringe will be returned to the shipping shield for return to the vendor. Each source will be assayed in a dose calibrator.

ITEM 9 FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT

<u>FACILITY DIAGRAM</u>: The facility is located on the ground floor of a multistory office building and is part of the FRC Radiological Suite which occupies the entire floor. The Nuclear Medicine Clinic area is located in the northeast corner bounded on two sides by the external walls of the building which is a masonry construction and by a hallway and an x-ray room. The clinic consists of three imaging rooms, a radiopharmacy, a thyroid uptake room, patient injection area, bathroom, patient changing rooms, and a small dedicated patient sitting area. Access to the clinic is via a controlled hallway accessed from the general patient waiting area via the reception desk. The radiopharmacy consists of a nonporous countertop, sink, cabinets, and an area for radioactive waste storage. The radiopharmacy area can be locked separate from the rest of the clinic spaces.

<u>RADIATION MONITORING INSTRUMENTS</u>: The clinic will have three nuclear gamma cameras for imaging patients – one new unit and two moved from the old site. All other equipment is as stated in the current license.

<u>DOSE CALIBRATOR</u>: The Nuclear Medicine Clinic uses only unit doses provided by a licensed Nuclear Pharmacy or radiopharmaceutical manufacturers. The primary method of verifying activity of each dose will be by use of a dose calibrator, Capentec Model 30, SN 70969. In the event of unavailability of the Dose Calibrator the clinic will rely on the recorded activity (adjusted for decay) provided by the radiopharmacy and/or radiopharmaceutical manufacturer providing the unit dose.

The dose calibrator will be calibrated in accordance with nationally recognized standards or the manufacturer's instructions.

This is as currently being done.

OTHER EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES: The new clinic will have additional safety equipment consisting of syringe shields, vial shields, a lead shielded "L" block with leaded window to manipulate unshielded syringes, forceps for handling unshielded RAM as appropriate, lab coats and disposable gloves. Lead lined RAW containers are available and a decontamination kit is available to handle contamination events should they occur. All unit doses are received in lead syringe "pigs." Single use aerosol trap kits are used for aerosol lung imaging.


