<u>MEMORANDUM AND ORDER</u> (Dismissing proceeding as moot)

On September 12, 2005, in LBP-05-25, 62 NRC ___, we held in abeyance the July 19, 2005 motion of the Department of the Army to dismiss this materials license amendment proceeding involving its Jefferson Proving Ground (JPG) site in Indiana on which a substantial quantity of depleted uranium (DU) munitions is now amassed. The basis of the motion was that, whereas the proceeding involved an application for a five-year renewable possession only license (POLA), the Army had now decided to abandon the POLA proposal in favor of seeking Commission approval of an alternate schedule for the submittal of a decommissioning plan for the JPG site. For the reasons set forth in LBP-05-25, which do not require repetition here, we concluded that, in the circumstances, the appropriate course was to reinstate a previously conditionally dismissed proceeding (Docket No. 40-8838-MLA) likewise concerned with the JPG site and the accumulated DU munitions;¹ to refer the reinstatement to the Commission for its consideration; and to await the Commission's response before acting on the motion to dismiss the proceeding at bar.

The Commission has now spoken. CLI-05-23, 62 NRC ____ (Oct. 26, 2005). It has affirmed the reinstatement of Docket No. 40-8838-MLA, although directing that its further adjudication be conducted by a licensing board rather than by this presiding officer and special assistant. Accordingly, there is no longer any reason to keep the proceeding at bar alive and it is hereby <u>dismissed as moot</u>.
