Enclosed is Amendment No. 64 to your NRC Material License No. 21-04073-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

This amendment deletes your intravascular brachytherapy authorizations for the Cordis and the Guidant Galileo devices. As a result, several Conditions and authorizations were deleted and/or modified. Also, I noted that the NRC address used on your letter dated July 22, 2005, was incorrect as it referenced our former office at "801 Warrenville Road." Please note that we moved in April 2004 and you should have received a postcard advising you of our new address, shown in the letterhead above.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS).
