


The purpose of this modification is to (1) obligate funds in the amount of \$15,180 for NRR for temporary clerical support; (2) clarify that the government will furnish the contractor general office supplies (in addition to the on-site equipment) required to perform the services under the subject contract; and (3) incorporate two (2) new within-scope incidental tasks under the contract at no additional cost to the government. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified as follows:

1. Under Section B.2, CONSIDERATION AND OBLIGATION-DELIVERY ORDERS (JUN 1989), the first sentence of paragraph (a) is revised as follows:

 “(a) The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$401,386.41.”
2. Under Subsection C.16, GOVERNMENT FURNISHED EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (JANUARY 2001), subparagraph (a) is deleted and replaced with the following revised language for subparagraph (a):

 “(a) The NRC will provide the contractor with all the equipment and general office supplies necessary to perform the required services.”
3. Under Subsection C.16, GOVERNMENT FURNISHED EQUIPMENT/PROPERTY (JANUARY 2001), add a new subparagraph (to be listed as “subparagraph (e)”) which states the following:

 “(e) Contractor personnel who have been authorized by the NRC Project Officer may enter NRC's Supply Room to acquire supplies for the program office they support. Only those contractor personnel who have been granted “final” IT access approval from the NRC Security Office will be granted this access. The NRC Project Officer will notify the contractor and the NRC Technical Monitor of the contractor personnel who have been granted the Supply Room access. The contractor shall be responsible for informing its employees that the sole purpose of access to the Supply Room is to either obtain supplies needed to perform the secretarial support services they provide, or to pickup supplies required by NRC staff. The contractor shall be responsible for informing its employees that government furnished supplies shall not be used for personal use. The NRC Project Officer shall rescind this authority for any contractor personnel who no longer qualifies for this access, based on NRC's criteria in effect at that time (NRC reserves the right to revise the criteria at any time).”

3. The following is incorporated as Section C.26:

"C.26, NRC REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTRACT SECRETARIES TO ESCORT VISITORS ON-SITE

Contract personnel who have been authorized by the NRC Project Officer may escort visitors within the NRC's premises. The NRC Project Officer will only provide this authority to those contractor personnel who have been granted "final" IT access and provided with escort briefings by the NRC Security office. The NRC Project Office will notify the contractor and the NRC Technical Monitor of those contractor personnel who have been granted authority to escort visitors. The Technical Monitor will request the contract personnel to escort visitors when the work requires this service. The NRC Project Officer shall rescind this authority for any contractor personnel who no longer qualifies for this authority, based on NRC's criteria in effect at that time (NRC reserves the right to revise the criteria at any time)."

All other terms and conditions, including the ceiling amount of \$1,397,375, remain unchanged.

A summary of obligations, from the award date through the date of this modification, are provided below:

This modification obligates FY 05 funds in the amount of \$15,180.
