SUBJECT: Amendment to Source Materials License

The Defense National Stockpile Center (DNOSC) requests an amendment to the subject license which would permit us to assess dose and Derived Concentration Guideline Levels (DCGL) with conversion factors from Federal Guidance Report 13 (EPA 402-R-99-001), Cancer Risk Coefficients for Environmental Exposure to Radionuclides. This request is limited to the decommissioning efforts at the DNOSC Binghamton Depot, Hoyt Avenue, Binghamton, NY, 13901-1699 and the DNOSC Somerville Depot, 152 US Highway 206 South, Hillsboro, NJ, 08844-4135.

Reference is made to the NRC Decommissioning Workshop, Universities at Shady Grove, Rockville, MD, April 20-21, 2005. At that meeting, NRC representatives agreed that the more up-to-date dosimetry data from FG Report 13 may be used for developing site-specific DCGLs with prior NRC permission.

We understand that upon approval only FG Report 13 data may be used at these sites and will replace FG Report 11 (EPA520-1-88-020) Limiting Values of Radionuclide Intake and Air Concentration and Dose Conversion Factors for Inhalation, Submersion, and Ingestion.
