SUMMARY

By application dated October 18, 2005, the Department of the Navy requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 5830, for the Model No. SNAP-21 package. The Department of the Navy did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed with an expiration date of October 1, 2008.

EVALUATION

By application dated October 18, 2005, the Department of the Navy requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 5830, for the Model No. SNAP-21 package. The Department of the Navy did not request any changes to the package design or authorized contents. The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package and found them to be adequate.

The following changes have been made to the Certificate:

Condition No. 7 of the certificate was revised to clarify that the package is approved for use under the general license provisions of 10 CFR 71.17. This change is due to a revision in the numbering of the sections in 10 CFR Part 71, that became effective on October 1, 2004 (69 FR 3698).

Condition No. 8 of the certificate authorizes use of the previous revision of the certificate for a period of approximately one year.

Condition No. 9 was changed to reflect the new expiration date. In accordance with 10 CFR 71.19(a)(3), Type B() packages are no longer authorized for use after October 1, 2008.

The October 18, 2005, submittal was included in the reference section.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed with an expiration date of October 1, 2008. This change does not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
