This letter is in reference to your petition for rulemaking dated November 3, 2005, that was submitted to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). You request that the NRC amend its regulations to require that an individual receive at least 40 hours of radiation safety training prior to using sources of radiation for industrial radiography, by clarifying the requirements for at least two individuals to be present at a temporary job site, and by clarifying how many individuals are required to meet surveillance requirements. Your letter has been docketed as a petition for rulemaking under 10 CFR 2.802 and assigned Docket Number PRM-34-06. We will inform you of the status of your petition as staff action on it progresses.
