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2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 44 x 48Y Cylinders loaded on two lash barges. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, URANIUM HEXAFLUORIDE, non fissile or fissile-excepted. Total net weight of U is 360,800 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is w2552 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule

The surface transportation from Metropolis, IL to Paducah, KY will be the responsibility of TAM International Inc. The US inland waterway transportation from Paducah, KY to New Orleans, LA will be the responsibility of American Commercial Barge Line.
