This refers to your response dated September 12, 2005, to the subject U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) inspection report and Notice of Violation (NOV). We have reviewed your response and found it to be acceptable.

NRC notes your response includes a commitment for an action tracking item in your Quality Tracking System for revision to the NAC-LWT Safety Analysis Report. This revision would require performance of appropriate specific tests prior to use of sealed canisters to confirm their ability to be vacuum dried and stay sealed during subsequent underwater handling for loading into the NAC-LWT packaging. Please keep NRC Staff apprised of your schedule for submitting the CoC amendment.

The implementation of the corrective actions you described in your response dated September 12, 2005, may be reviewed in future inspections.
