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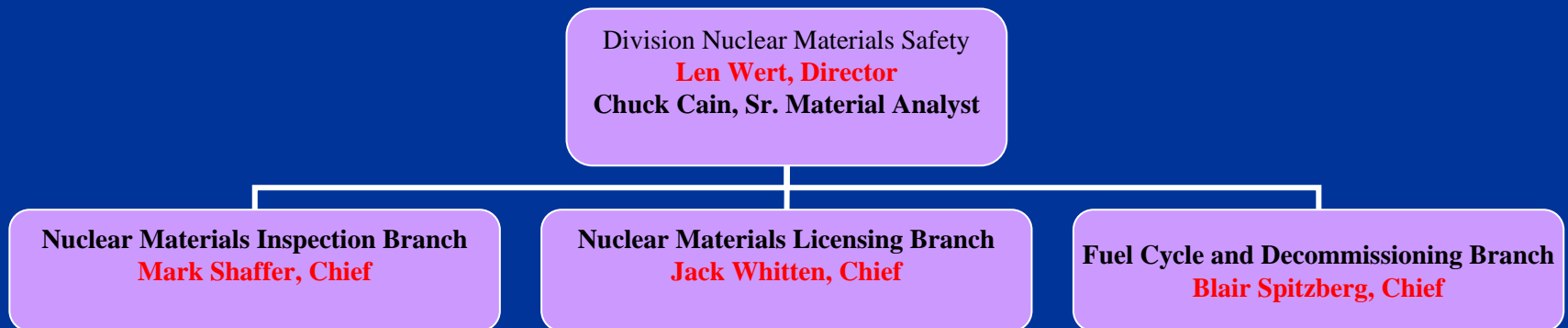

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# Types of Routine Inspections

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- **Pre-operational**- None planned in FY 2005.
- **Operational**- (ISLs, conventional facilities in standby and reclamation) 5 planned in FY 2005.
- **Close-out**- (reclamation activities complete) 1 planned in FY 2005.

# Routine Inspection Schedules

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## Inspection frequency:

- **Once** per year at all operating facilities.
- **Every two years** at facilities in reclamation and standby, unless operating conditions or performance indicates otherwise.
- **Every three years** for inactive facilities.

# **Focus of Inspections**

**Risk Informed & Performance Based**

**Inspections Focus on Risk Significant Activities:**

- **Yellowcake Dryer Operations**
- **Health Physics Activities in Routine Operations**
- **Decommissioning & Reclamation**
  - **Focus on facility demolition & dismantlement**
  - **Tailings & Pond Construction & Maintenance**
- **11e.(2) Disposal**
