Dear Mr. Williams:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether a former nuclear security officer with the Wackenhut Corporation was the subject of employment discrimination for raising nuclear safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the allegation was not substantiated. The NRC plans no further action related to alleged discrimination and considers this investigation closed.
