Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact

for License Amendment for Framatome ANP, Inc., Lynchburg, VA

I agree with the Finding of No Significant Impact for this amendment. The administrative change has nothing to do with release limits to the environment, and is limited to defining exposure limits for occupational workers to airborne radioactive material within the facility. In general the 10 CFR Part 20 Appendix B provides a safety factor of 100 to occupational workers. It is recognized within the scientific community that the newer ICRP values are closer to the intended exposure limits. In other words, the existing NRC regulatory exposure limits for various radio isotopes may offer more protection than may be needed when considering other socio-economic factors, which is why NRC allows granting exemptions on a case- by-case basis. I see not objection to NRC granting this exemption.
