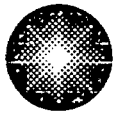

**Subj: Notification of Intent to Submit a Combined Construction and Operating License Application: Follow-up to November 2, 2005, Meeting**

Constellation Generation Group, LLC ("Constellation") submits this letter to summarize the major points presented in our public meeting held with the NRC Staff at NRC Headquarters on the afternoon of Wednesday, November 2, 2005. As presented in that meeting, Constellation and its UniStar Nuclear partner, AREVA/Framatome ANP ("FANP") intend to submit Part 52 applications for a new nuclear construction project within the upcoming years. More specifically, FANP intends to submit a Design Certification application ("DCA") for the U.S. Evolutionary Power Reactor ("U.S. EPR") by December 2007 and Constellation Generation Group, LLC, intends to submit a Combined Construction and Operating License application ("COLA")—referencing the aforementioned DCA—by June 2008.

The COL application in 2008 will be the first in what is expected to be a series of similar projects by UniStar Nuclear. Therefore, we are interested in working with the NRC to define areas of efficiency for follow-on COLAs that are similar to the first application.


As stated in the meeting, Constellation does not intend to reference an Early Site Permit in its COLA. Site selection for this first of several potential projects is expected to occur in early 2006. We will notify you as soon as practicable regarding that decision.

In addition to documenting our intent to submit a COLA for a specific design, this letter should initiate the NRC process that establishes a project number and assigns a Project Manager for our COLA pre-application activities.
