BROWNS FERRY NUCLEAR PLANT (BFN) UNIT 2 - WITHDRAWAL OF TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS (TS) CHANGE TS-454 - ONE-TIME EXTENSION TO LOW PRESSURE EMERGENCY CORE COOLING SYSTEM COMPLETION TIME (CT)

On November 21, 2005, the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) submitted a request for an emergency TS change (TS-454) to license DPR-52 for BFN Unit 2. The proposed change was to revise on a one-time basis the current Unit 2 low pressure Emergency Core Cooling System (ECCS) injection/spray CT from 7 days to 14 days. The purpose of increasing the CT was to provide additional time for the on-going repair of a Low Pressure Coolant Injection (LPCI) motor-generator (MG) set.

However, TVA was successful in completing repairs to the LPCI MG set within the current TS CT. On November 22, 2005, at 11:15 AM, operability of the associated ECCS equipment was restored and the relevant limiting conditions for operation were exited. TVA hereby withdraws TS-454.
