## LICENSEE'S ANSWER TO AUGUST 18, 2004 COMMISSION ORDER TO MODIFY LICENSE FOR INTERIM SAFEGUARDS AND SECURITY MEASURES

On August 18, 2004, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC" or "Commission") issued an immediately effective order in the captioned matter entitled Order Modifying Licenses (Effective Immediately) ("Order") to all 10 CFR Part 72 licensees who currently have an Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation ("ISFSI") under the general license provisions of 10 CFR Part 72, including to, *inter alia*, Entergy Operations, Inc. ("Entergy") for its Arkansas Nuclear One facility. The Order stated that certain additional security measures are required to address the current threat environment in a manner consistent throughout the nuclear ISFSI community.<sup>1</sup> The Commission stated its determination that actions already taken to increase security at ISFSIs should be supplemented further because the current threat environment continues to exist. Therefore, the Commission imposed requirements as set forth in Attachment 1 of the Order.<sup>2</sup> Entergy has responded to the substantive requirements of the

On October 16, 2002, the Commission had ordered licensees of operating ISFSIs to take certain actions and implement additional security enhancements to protect such facilities.

Order by letter dated September 7, 2004, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 72.4, as directed by the Order.<sup>3</sup>

In accordance with Section IV of the Order and 10CFR2.202, Entergy hereby submits its Answer to the Order. Entergy consents to the Order and specifically does not request a hearing.
