On August 18, 2004, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued an order, effective immediately, (Reference 1) regarding additional access authorization measures for Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) facilities.

In paragraph A.2 of Attachment I to the order transmittal letter, the NRC stated, "Licensees whose Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) is located at the same site as an operating power reactor for their ISFSI(s) may implement the compensatory measures for access authorization for operating power reactors issued January 7, 2003, [Reference 2] as an alternate means of complying with this Order. Licensees shall clearly distinguish in their 20-day response which method they intend to apply to comply with these ASMs."

By letter dated January 06, 2004 (Reference 3), Entergy provided assurance of compliance with the Order for Compensatory Measures Related to Access Authorization, dated January 7, 2003.


