


ANSWER TO AUGUST 18, 2004
COMMISSION ORDER TO MODIFY LICENSE ASSOCIATED WITH
ACCESS AUTHORIZATION

On August 18, 2004, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC" or "Commission") issued an immediately effective order in the captioned matter entitled Order Modifying License (Effective Immediately) ("Order") to, *inter alia*, Exelon Generation Company, LLC ("Exelon") and AmerGen Energy Company, LLC (AmerGen"). The Order stated the Commission determined that independent spent fuel storage installations be required to implement additional security measures to address the current threat environment. The NRC stated it was imposing

requirements as set forth in Attachment 1 of the Order.¹ Exelon and AmerGen have responded to the substantive requirements of the Order by letter dated September 7, 2004, in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 72.4, as directed by the Order.

In accordance with Section IV of the Order and 10 CFR 2.202, Exelon and AmerGen consent to the Order and specifically do not request a hearing to the Order.




