Summary:	<p>So that the license may be terminated, we need to get a statement of what areas had licensed material, what types of licensed materials were used, and the surveys which released those areas. Guidance is located in NUREG-1757, Volume 1, Revision 1. Review guidance for group 2 Decommissioning and simplified survey procedures in Figure 8.1.</p> <p>Additionally, leak tests results should be provided for all sealed sources within 6 months of transfer unless those leak tests have been submitted previously. The leak test of your last sealed source submitted was not within 6 months.</p> <p>This termination will require an environmental assessment which needs additional information. I will send another letter discussing the needed information.</p>
