Subject: Submittal of Application for License Amendment to Delete License Condition
SG-3.1 (License Number SNM-33, Docket 70-36)

Westinghouse hereby submits this application for an amendment to License Number SNM-33 to delete License Condition SG-3.1. This amendment is being requested to reflect the fact that the IAEA has de-listed the Hematite facility as a Transitional Facility under the US/IAEA Agreement. License Condition SG-3.1 implemented the requirement that, as a Transitional Facility, Westinghouse utilize the material codes specified in the US/IAEA Agreement. Therefore this license condition is no longer necessary.

Do to the decommissioning status of the facility, Westinghouse will not make the computer changes that would be necessary to change over to the NRC material codes. Instead, Westinghouse will continue to use the IAEA material codes pending, at least, the removal of the current Uranium inventory from the site.
