On July 14, 2005, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received, and initiated review of United Nuclear Corporation's (UNC) revised license amendment request for changing the ground water protection standard for Pb-210 in Source Materials License SUA-1475. Recently (September 30, 2005), the NRC received a supplemental request for changing the ground water protection standard for radium in Source Materials License SUA-1475. As a result, we are closing Technical Assignment Control (TAC) No. LU0092, and are generating a new TAC number that will include both the Pb-210, and radium proposals.
