This is to inform you that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Regulatory Issues Summary (RIS) 2005-23, "Clarification of the Physical Presence Requirement During Gamma Stereotactic Radiosurgery (GSR) Treatments."

This RIS clarifies the definition of the term "physically present," as used in 10 CFR 35.615(f)(3).
