This letter is in reference to your letter dated September 17, 1993, "Additional Information Regarding the Remediation and Final Survey of Buildings 7, 8, 9 and 10A at the Westinghouse Bloomfield, NJ Facility."

Attached is a copy of the description of the plan and methods used by the Westinghouse Electric Corporation to demonstrate that radioactive contamination levels within the documented survey areas of Buildings 7, 8, 9 and 10A at the Bloomfield Lamp Plant have been reduced to levels below criteria established for release for unrestricted use. This plan has been developed in accordance with the Draft NUREG/CR-5849, Manual for Conducting Radiological Surveys in Support of License Termination; the NRC's 1987 Guidlines for Decontamination of Facilities and Equipment Prior to Release for Unrestricted Use or Termination of Licenses for Byproduct Source or Special Nuclear Materials; and the NRC's 1981 Branch Technical Position Disposal or On-site Storage of Thorium or Uranium from Past Operations. It supplements and updates the Westinghouse Electric Corporation, August 1992, Radiological Decontamination Confirmatory Survey, Westinghouse Bloomfield Lamp Plant, Buildings 7, 8 and 9.
