BEAVER VALLEY POWER STATION, UNITS 1 AND 2, LICENSE RENEWAL
APPLICATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff (NRC or the staff) and representatives of FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) held a telephone conference call on June 28, 2005, to discuss and clarify the staff's comments concerning the Beaver Valley Power Station, Units 1 and 2, previous license renewal application. The conference call was useful in clarifying the staff's examples of deficiencies found in the license renewal application. The following items were discussed: (1) Components in scope - Section 2; (2) Fatigue Monitoring Program; (3) Application tables and notes; (4) Steam Generator Tube Inspection; (5) Risk Assessment - profiles and unit differences; (6) Boric Acid Program - management vs. detection; (7) Stress corrosion cracking vs. fatigue; and (8) Checklist items.

Enclosure 1 provides a listing of the telephone conference call participants.
