In accordance with your application dated September 15, 2004, and pursuant to Part 72 of Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Materials License SNM-2507 for the North Anna Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation is hereby amended to revise Appendix A, Technical Specifications. The changes will revise Section 5.0, Administrative Controls, to change the reference location where the plant-specific titles and TS titles are correlated, and relocate the facility staff qualification requirements to the Quality Assurance (QA) Program.
