Gentlemen:


Please amend license SNM-777 to include a second boat calciner furnace.

The new furnace is similar to the existing furnace; it is arranged such that the existing glove boxes and return tube servicing the existing furnace will also service this furnace.

Also, the Bay XIII Bunkers described in Subpart 917.1 and glove box 119B described in Subpart 922.5 are not used and are hereby deleted from Reference 1. and SNM-777 dated November 25, 1964 as amended.

A revised Subpart 922.14, Boat Calciner System, consisting of the following listed pages is submitted herewith in support of this application. Please note that Subpart 922.14 of Reference 1 corresponds to Subpart 302.15 of SNM-777 dated November 25, 1964 as amended.
