

1. Provide a complete description of the transaction (transfer of stocks or assets, or merger).

We don't know the definitive details yet.

2. Describe any changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. Include training and experience for new personnel.

Raleigh General Hospital does not anticipate any change in personnel or the current duties which are assigned.

3. Describe any changes in organization, location, facilities, equipment or procedures that relate to the licensed program?

No change in location, facilities, equipment or procedures.

4. Describe the status of surveillance program (surveys, wipe test, quality control) at the present time and the expected status at the time that control is to be transferred.

The surveillance program is current and up to date and we will undergo our 4th quarter Physicist visit in December 2005. The surveillance program and all other associated daily testing will continue uninterrupted during this transfer and after it has been completed.

5. Confirm that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels and fixed and/or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.

All records will be maintained in their current condition as the transfer will be transparent at the facility level. No change in record keeping of surveys.

6. Confirm that the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements and commitments of the transferor or that the transferee will submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.

All conditions of the current license will be maintained before, during and after transfer of ownership. No change in licensed program.
