CONCERNING APPLICATION FOR NEW LICENSE, CONTROL NO. 137964

Dear Dr. Purohit:

This is to confirm the telephone conversation on December 7, 2005 between Mark Dater and Dennis Lawyer in which we discussed the information we need to continue review of your application dated November 7, 2005. The items discussed are specified below.

- 1. You have submitted your name for the position of Radiation Safety Officer. As Dennis Lawyer discussed with Mr. Dater during the telephone conversation, Radiation Safety Officers must meet the requirements of 10 CFR 35.50. Additional information to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 35.50 would need to be submitted. Alternatively, you may request a different person to be the Radiation Safety Officer and submit their training and experience. Please refer to the NRC website as this rule was changed on March 30, 2005 for these requirements.
- 2. The following needed information was missing from the attestation statement signed by Dr. David Drout. The dates and the location where the work experience in table 5a of the submitted NRC form 313a was obtained needs to be submitted.
- 3. The attestation statement for yourself did not include work experience as described by 10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G). As required by 10 CFR 35.290(c)(2), a written attestation, signed by a preceptor authorized user who meets the requirements in 10 CFR 35.290, 35.390 and 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G), or equivalent Agreement State requirements, that the individual has satisfactorily completed the requirements in paragraph 10 CFR 35.290(c)(1)(ii)(G).

Or you may obtain these documents by contacting the Government Printing Office (GPO) toll-free at 1-888-293-6498. We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to the attention of Dennis Lawyer at the Region I Office and refer to Mail Control No. 137964. If you have any technical questions regarding this deficiency letter, please call Dennis Lawyer at (610) 337-5366.

If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.
