
We make the following requests with regards to license number 45-16209-02: 03014703

1. Please add the rooms noted on the attached diagram which contain treadmills for stress injections of radioactive materials.
2. Please delete the strontium-90 source, 3M Model 6D1A, removed from this facility by Adco Services, Inc. on July 14, 2005. See attached documentation of the disposal.
3. Please also remove all 10 CFR 31.11 authorizations from our license, since these laboratory studies have not been performed here for several years. All areas previously used have been surveyed by the RSO and found free of residual contamination.

Our Radiation Safety Committee has reviewed this amendment request along with additional information provided and all members are in agreement with these requests and commitments.
